



China Travel Itinerary Project

You will be showing your understanding of ancient China by creating a trip and travel itinerary for a visit to China that focuses on places that were important during ancient times. Your final product will include a trip cover sheet, map showing which locations you will visit, and completed travel itinerary information tables.

The following places MUST be visited.

1. Huang River
2. Anyang
3. The Great Wall of China
4. Terra Cotta Warriors
5. Confucius Temple
6. One location of your choice (this does not have to relate to ancient China)

To complete your project, follow these steps:

Read the pages in your social studies book on China (pages 158-178), also visit the website for additional information. Use the note-taking/vocabulary sheet as you read and visit the sites via the internet.

Step One:

- ✓ Locate and identify each stop on the map of China. You will draw in the Huang River in blue, and then place the other five locations you will visit on the map using different colors.
- ✓ Decide in which order you will visit each place and number them on your rough draft map. When you are finished, you will transfer the information to the final map.

Step Two:

- ✓ Using the itinerary information tables, fill out the information about each location. You will write an informational paragraph about each stop that will inform visitors about the importance of the site and explain how this location was important during ancient times.
- ✓ Finally, fill-in in the cover sheet on the next page; proofread all papers, and then turn in.
